

Pleasant Valley Eyesore?



Washington Co., MD is proposing to erect a communications tower at the intersection of Keep Tryst and Sandy Hook Roads. The proposed tower would stick up 190' and would ruin spectacular views that now exist from Weverton Cliffs, Loudoun Heights, Maryland Heights, and Harpers

Ferry. The National Park Service has called the proposed tower "unsightly and unnecessary".
