In an effort to provide seamless coverage in your area, T-Mobile is seeking approval of a Special Exception from Frederick County, Maryland. As part of the approval process with Frederick County, T-Mobile is required to notify you of our proposed application. T-Mobile is expanding its network to not only achieve additional coverage around your area both in your vehicle and in your home, but also to provide Enhanced 911 for emergency situations.


The application details are as follows:

T-Mobile is proposing a telecommunication facility to be located at 3857 South Mountain Road, Knoxville, MD 21758. The proposed facility will consist of a 150-ft telecommunications stealth unipole with six (6) antennas attached at centerline heights of 147 feet and 140 feet. All of the telecommunications antennas will be completely enclosed within the stealth unipole. The installation will also include the placement of three (3) equipment cabinets to be located on a 10-ft by 20-ft concrete pad within a newly-constructed eight (8) foot high wooden fenced compound measuring 25 feet by 40 feet. Finally, a ten (10) foot wide landscaping buffer will be planted surrounding the fenced compound.

An informational meeting will be held for members of the public who wish to attend on Monday, November 9, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. at the Media Center of the Brunswick Middle School, 301 Cummings Drive, Brunswick, MD 21716.
